

Pencil Stroke Types

In this chart, let's look at the most common types of strokes:



- These are linear strokes, shaded in one direction only. Put your pencil sideways and quickly shade an area in one direction.
- This sample shows the same type of linear strokes, but going in a different direction.
- These are parallel lines that are shaded in one direction and then in the other direction. Often called crosshatching, this stroke is the most useful type of shading in colored pencil work.
- 4. This sample shows crosshatching that is done in two colors, red and blue. You can see that the colored pencils are actually semi-transparent when applied with a light pencil pressure.
- These are soft, circular strokes done in a single color, and then in two different colors, red and blue.

- Stippling is the technique of placing tiny dots next to each other to create a unique color gradation.
- Zigzag lines are scratchy, uneven lines that often help to make texture, such as you would use for coloring grass.
- These short, linear lines are similar to the strokes shown in 1 and 2, but they're uneven and aim to "read" as separate lines.
- 9. This sample shows lines placed so tightly to each other that they read as a blur. By varying the pencil pressure, you can go from dark to light using a single colored pencil, and essentially that's what it means to make a color gradation.
