- 1. Print on white or colored card stock. (Either the side with the gray gradation or the unprinted side can be used as the "right" side.)
- 2. Flame and/or halo and or candle may be colored in with colored pencils, markers etc. Always add color before cutting out the shape.
- 3. Cut out along outside solid line. Include or exclude halo around the flame, as desired. To shorten: trim the bottom edge. To lengthen: Add to the bottom edge and use the back side of the paper as the right side of your candle.
- 4. Roll candle portion. Roll more tightly for a skinnier candle or loosely for a wider candle. Rolling around a pen or pencil helps.
- 5. Fold blank circle portion down to create a covered top of the candle.
- 6. Glue to secure.
