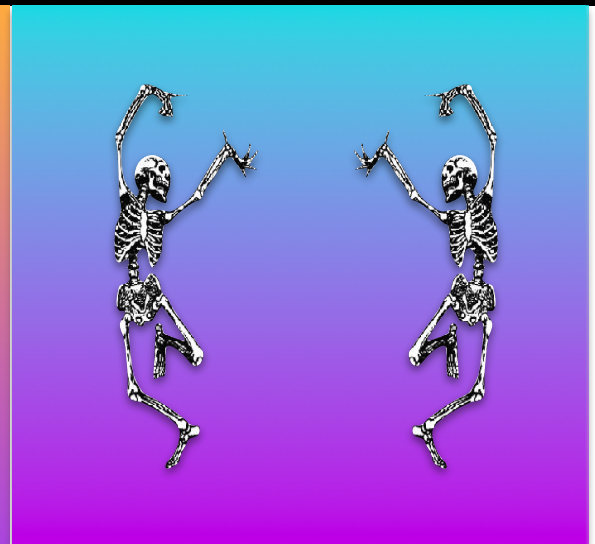
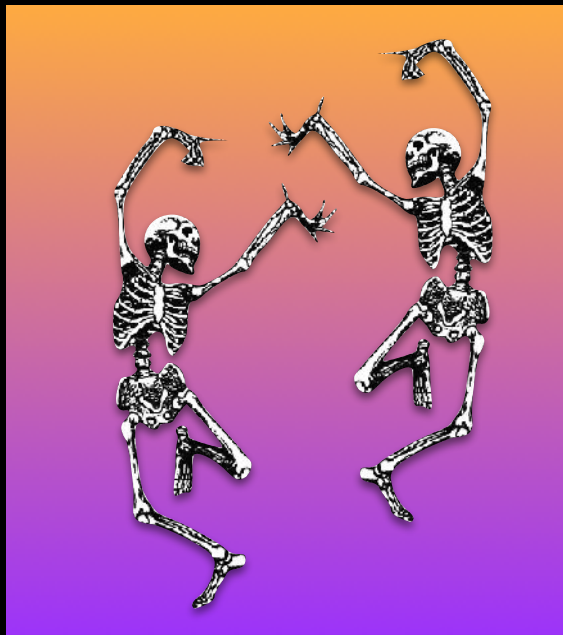
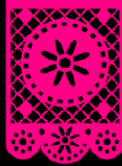
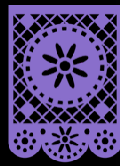
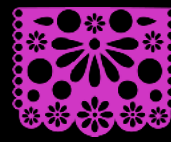


## SMALL FRAMES

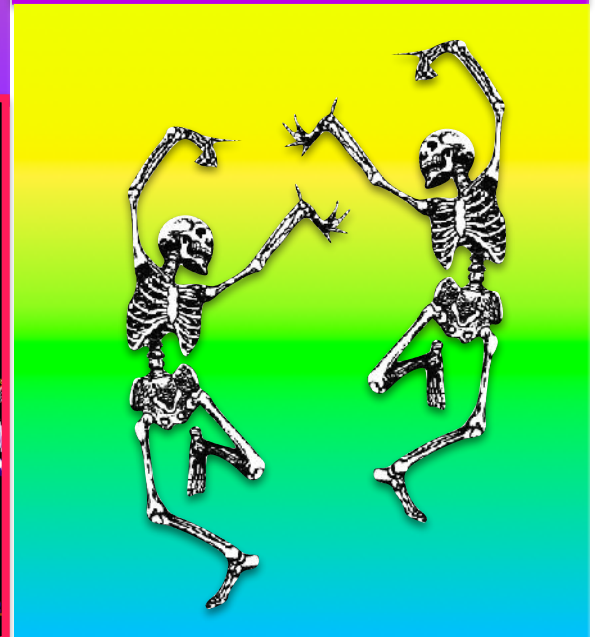
